SUMMARY OF HONORS MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

1. Completion of psychology major requirements includes a minimum of 36 credits. Students may request evaluation of non-psychology UMN courses with substantially similar content or transfer psychology courses for consideration of inclusion in the major program.
2. Students must complete a minimum of 16 upper level credits in the major as UMN-TC credit.
3. University of Minnesota– Twin Cities Uniform Policies:
 - All courses used to fulfill minimum requirements must be completed A-F.
 - Students must receive a grade of C- or better for all courses in the major.
 - Students must graduate with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better in courses taken to fulfill major requirements, although a higher GPA is required for graduation with Honors.
