SUMMARY OF MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

1. Completion of psychology major requirements includes a minimum of 36 credits. Students may request evaluation of non-psychology UMN courses with substantially similar content or transfer psychology courses for consideration of inclusion in the major program.
2. Students completing a double major in another CLA department who choose to complete that department's major project must complete 36 total credits in psychology, using additional electives to replace credits that would have been earned through Psychology's major project.
3. Students must complete a minimum of 16 upper level credits in the major as UMN-TC credit.
4. University of Minnesota- Twin Cities Uniform Policies:
 - All courses used to fulfill minimum requirements must be completed A-F.
 - Students must receive a grade of C- or better for all courses in the major.
 - Students must graduate with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better in courses taken to fulfill major requirements.
